



SUMMER SERVICE SCHEDULE 2026

As the summer holiday season approaches, we would like to share some important information to help you plan your logistics activities accordingly.

THE NETHERLANDS...

Our services in the Netherlands will remain fully operational throughout the summer. However, between weeks 33 and 35, delivery frequencies may be reduced due to holiday schedules, which could result in longer transit times than usual.

NORTHERN EUROPE...

DENMARK, NORWAY, SWEDEN AND FINLAND

Our services across Northern Europe will continue without interruption during the summer period. However, from weeks 29 to 31, collections and deliveries may take place less frequently due to seasonal holidays. As a result, shipments may experience extended transit times.

CENTRAL EUROPE...

BELGIUM, LUXEMBOURG, GERMANY, AUSTRIA, SWITZERLAND AND THE UNITED KINGDOM

Operations in Central Europe will remain active throughout the summer. Nevertheless, between weeks 32 and 35, reduced collection and delivery frequencies may occur due to holiday periods, which could lead to longer transit times than normal.

SOUTHERN EUROPE...

FRANCE, ITALY, PORTUGAL AND SPAIN

The summer holiday season has a greater impact on logistics operations in Southern Europe. Between weeks 32 and 35, many businesses are closed due to widespread summer shutdowns, particularly during August.

As a result, shipments may be delayed or, in some cases, temporarily unable to be collected or delivered.

To ensure that your B2C shipments reach their destinations in Southern Europe before the main holiday period, we recommend that goods are received by us no later than week 28. For B2B shipments, the recommended final receiving week is week 29, except for shipments destined for islands, Portugal, Southern France and Southern Italy. For these destinations, week 28 should also be considered the latest receiving week.

PLEASE SHARE YOUR SUMMER SCHEDULE

We kindly ask you to inform us of any planned summer closures or reduced opening hours at your facilities and/or at your collection and delivery addresses.

If we do not receive any information regarding holiday closures, we will assume that shipments available for collection can also be delivered to their final destination as usual.

Our offices and warehouses will remain open throughout the entire summer period, and our team will be available every business day to support you as always.



CHRISTMAS PERIOD SERVICE SCHEDULE 2026

Although summer is still in full swing, we would like to draw your attention to several international public holidays later this year. Around these dates, driving restrictions and/or company closures may affect transport operations and transit times.

While we will do everything possible to minimise any disruption, we recommend taking the dates below into account when planning your shipments.



REFORMATION DAY 31 OCTOBER...

In some countries, Reformation Day is an official public holiday and driving restrictions may apply. This may affect our linehaul services to Belgium, France and Germany. Please take possible delays into account.



ALL SAINTS' DAY 1 NOVEMBER...

As All Saints' Day falls on a Sunday this year, it will have no impact on our services.



CHRISTMAS AND NEW YEAR...

The following office opening hours will apply:

- 21, 22, 23, 28, 29 and 30 December: open from 08:00 to 17:00
- 24 and 31 December: open from 08:00 to 12:00
- 25 and 26 December, and 1 January: closed

The following warehouse receiving hours will apply:

- 21, 22, 23, 28, 29 and 30 December: 06:00 to 16:00
- 24 and 31 December: 06:00 to 12:00
- 25 and 26 December, and 1 January: closed

To ensure your goods arrive before Christmas, shipments must be delivered to Jan Krediet no later than the dates listed below.

EPIPHANY 6 JANUARY 2026

Epiphany is an official public holiday in several countries, including Germany, Switzerland, Austria, Poland, Spain, Italy, Finland and Sweden. As a result, our services may be affected and delays may occur.

During Week 1, linehaul services in Germany will only operate in Zones 1 and 2. No linehaul services will be available in German Zones 3 and 4, nor in Austria and Switzerland during Week 1.
